Flying Conduct

Pilots are reminded that when flying online for Aegean, they are a representative of AOVA when using their callsign.

Pilots are encouraged to remain patient with ATC and to show professionalism and good manners when flying.

If a pilot is ghosted during a live flight, it is possible that the matter will be investigated. The pilot might be suspended or directed to the tutorials pages.

When flying for Aegean Virtual, the callsign to be used is either "Olympic xxx", "Aegean xxx" or "AOVAxxx". The number can either be the flight number or your assigned callsign.

Flight Logging

All flights are to be logged in our Crew Center. A tutorial will be provided on how to log these and will be located in #documents.

A screenshot of your aircraft at the final destination or of your logbook, proving that you have flown the flight, might be requested by our Flight Logger.

If you fail to provide a screenshot of the logbook, then the matter might be investigated.

Every route is assigned a certain aircraft of the AOVA fleet. The route is to be flown with this aircraft. If you do not have access to this route, you cannot log this flight.

Routes

Pilots are permitted to fly any flight or StarCharter available to their rank.

StarCharter routes include selected Nordica, Adria Air, Ethiopian, EgyptAir and South African Routes

Rank System

Rank	Minimum Hours Needed	Aircraft Unlocked
1 – Olympic Trainee	0	DH8D
2 – First Officer	10	A319
3 – Captain	25	A320
4 – Senior Captain	35	A321
5 – Executive Pilot	50	C750
6 – Long Haul Pilot	100	A340
7 – Commander	150	B747

Rules

- 2 Sexually explicit behavior will result in an immediate dismissal from the VA
- 3 Logos cannot be copied or reproduced without allowance of staff
- 4 Due to AOVA not having an age limit, all content must remain child-friendly
